This provides the perfect opportunity to meet a travel need that falls outside normal requirements. For example, purchase your Flexjet 25 Jet Card on a legendary Learjet 40 XR and buy five additional hours on the long-range Challenger 300.

USING YOUR ADDITIONAL HOURS

- Take advantage of additional hours when they become available – availability varies by aircraft type.
- Use hours on any day that is available to you under your current jet card calendar, choosing from any aircraft in the Flexjet 25 Jet Card program fleet, operated by Jet Solutions.¹
- Purchase up to five additional hours per jet card – all at one time or on a per-hour basis.
- Carry any unused additional hours forward into your new jet card contract.²
- Use additional hours on multiple aircraft on an as-available basis.³

Who Is Eligible

All new and current Flexjet 25 Jet Card customers who purchase a 25-hour jet card or greater, including combination jet cards, after February 1, 2010,⁴ qualify to purchase additional hours.

Fly on High-Performance Aircraft

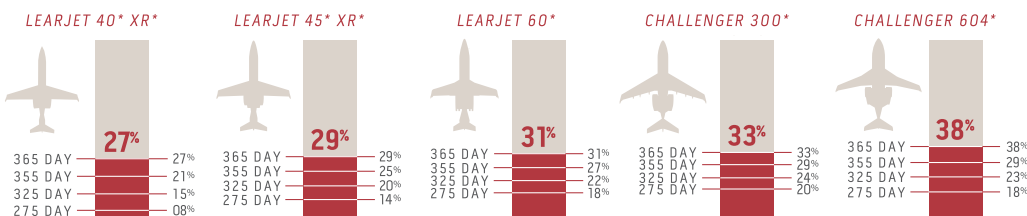
Purchase additional hours on any aircraft that is part of the Flexjet 25 Jet Card program. Choose hours on the aircraft that best meets your travel requirements, from among any of the Bombardier* Learjet* and Challenger* aircraft, operated by Jet Solutions.

Additional Hours Pricing

The total cost of additional hours is determined by three primary components: The additional hourly rate, the fuel component adjustment, and any associated taxes.⁵

Discount On Additional Hours



As a Flexjet 25 Jet Card customer, you benefit from a generous discount on additional hours, ranging from 8 percent to 38 percent off standard Flexjet 25 Jet Card program hourly rates, depending on aircraft type and travel calendar.

1 Additional hours not available on Peak Days, but may be used on any day that is available in the primary jet card travel calendar. Customers may fly additional hours on a non-available day by paying a non-available day surcharge. Additional hours for 365-day owners available on the 355-day calendar only.

2 If you reach the end of your Flexjet 25 Jet Card contract – whether because the contract expired or you have flown all of your hours – before using all additional hours, you may carry the unused additional hours into a new jet card purchase, so long as the additional hours are still used within 12 months of when the additional hours were purchased. Hours carried forward will be applied to the new jet cards five-hour limit.

3 Upgrades and downgrades not available with additional hours. Charter limit does not apply. Customers with an original contract on a Learjet are not eligible for the ferry fee waiver to Hawaii with the purchase of Challenger additional hours.

4 Stand-alone jet card purchases of 12.5-, 15.0-, or 17.5-hour are not eligible for this program.

5 Additional hours cannot be refunded once purchased.

Program Terms and Conditions

- Customers whose trip on additional hours exceeds the number of additional hours purchased will pay their original rate (parent contract) for those excess hours, with the appropriate interchange ratio from the parent contract, if they are flying in a different aircraft type.
- A credit card will be required for those who schedule a trip on additional hours, if estimated flight time is greater than the number of available additional hours.
- Offer good for the purchase of a 25-, 30-, or 35-hour Flexjet 25 Jet Card as additional hours are available. Must have purchased jet card after February 1, 2010. Customer must sign standard Flexjet 25 Jet Card agreement with Jet Solutions, LLC to be eligible for this program. Flights that exceed the five additional hours will be subject to an interchange ratio for the additional hours. Offer is nontransferable; not valid with other promotional offers.
